IN THE COURT OF THE HONOURABLE XXV METROPOLITAN MAGISTRATE
AT KUKATPALLY, MIYAPUR

Honoured Sir,

On 22.03.2016, while the Inspector of Police, Gachibowli and other police personnel were attending Law and Order bandobusth at University of Hyderabad, Sri. M. Sudhakar, Registrar- in-charge, University of Hyderabad handed over a written report to the Inspector of Police Gachibowli requesting necessary action. The contents of the petition are that the Vice Chancellor, University of Hyderabad joined back his duties on 22.03.2016 after the process of judicial deposition was over. At 9 AM, he met faculty members, non-teaching staff and students in the VC lodge. At 10 AM, he had convened a meeting of all Deans, Internal EC Members, Directors, College for integrated studies, Chief Proctor and DSW. While the meeting was going on, around 100 student led by Munna, Ramjee, Vijay Kumar, Lingam, Sanjay, Sesaiah, Venkatesh Cauhan, Kesaban Roy Choudhury, Dontha Prashanth went to the VC lodge by jumping over the main gate, broke open the main door, windows/door glass panes and entered the premises of VC's lodge. These students further became violent and ransacked the VC's lodge. They have also damaged the TV, furniture, computers and laptop. They were prevented from

entering the main room because of students and faculty members and thus saved the VC from physical harm. However, few of the faculty and students were injured because of the stone throwing and broken glass panes. The chief proctor had to be admitted in the hospital because of the tension and blood pressure. The Vice Chancellor, Deans of Schools and other senior faculty were confined in the room for more than 6 hours till the police had come and rescued them. They sat in the lawn for several hours and raised slogans against the Vice Chancellor and other members of the university. The act of violence indulged by these students caused enormous damage to public property besides threatened the people inside VC lodge. As such, he requested appropriate action be taken on those who indulged in violence at VC's lodge and threatened the people with dire consequences.

Based on the contents of the above report and endorsement of the LW12 received through PC. 2919 Sri. K.Venkat, the LW 10 acting as SHO PS Gachibowli registered a case in Cr. No. 113/2016 U/S 147, 452, 324, 506, 427, 342, 353 R/w 149 IPC and Sec. 3 of PDPP Act and sent the CD file to LW11 for investigation.

During the course of investigation the LW 11 has examined the LWs 1 to 7 and recorded their detail statements in part- II CD. The witnesses LWs 1 to 7 have revealed the identity of the accused A1 to A46. The LW 11 secured the presence of mediators i.e., LWs 8 and 9 and conducted panchanama of scene of offence, drawn rough sketch and also photographed the entire scene of offence.

The investigation done so far revealed that on 17.01.2016, one student by name Vemula Rohit Chakravarthy, pursuing Ph.D in University of Hyderabad had committed suicide in Room No. 207, I- Wing, NRS hostel, University of Hyderabad campus, Hyderabad. On the complaint of Dr. Vineeth CP Nair, Warden NRS hostel a case was registered on this vide case in Cr.No. 19/2016 U/S 174 Cr.PC and it is under investigation.

On 18.01.2016 at 0530 Hrs, one Dontha Prashanth who is also pursuing Ph.D in University of Hyderabad gave a complaint alleging that the said Vemula Rohit Chakravarthy, Ph.D student belonging to SC community committed suicide by hanging in the room No. 207, NRS hostel, I-wing due to the harassment by the Vice Chancellor and others for which a case vide Cr. No. 20/2016 U/S 306 IPC, 3(1)(ix)(x), (2) (vii) of SC&ST (POA) Act was registered and the same is under investigation. After this incident, the Vice Chancellor Sri. P.Appa Rao went on long leave as some of the students agitated against him.

On 22.03.2016, the LW 2 i.e., Vice Chancellor, University of Hyderabad joined back his duties in the early hours around 0800 AM along with his personal secretary i.e. LW. 3. Thereafter as per the instructions of LW 2, the LW 3 uploaded the message about the joining of LW 2 (VC) from long leave in their official website i.e. www.uohyd.ac.in and mailed to all Deans, directors, CIS (College for Integrated

services) etc; to attend the meeting at 10 AM. While the LW 2 had convened a meeting of all Deans, Internal EC Members, Directors, College for integrated studies, Chief Proctor and DSW around 1030 AM while the meeting was going on at VC lodge HCU campus, on knowing about the arrival and assuming charge of VC by Mr.P.Appa Rao, the accused A1 to A47 and others numbering about 200 persons gathered at north shopping complex, HCU formed into an un-lawful assembly with a common object to attack the VC, to prevent him assuming the charge of Vice Chancellor, to put the lives of VC and others into danger with an aggressive mood, all raised slogans as 'WE DON'T WANT TO BE SILENT WE SHOULD BE VIOLENT, WE KILL THE VC APPA RAO WE BRING OUR VC ' AND ALSO THEY GAVE SLOGANS IN HINDI SAYING "VC BACHKE KAHA JAYEGA AAJ NAHI THO KAL MILEGA, JINDA DAFNAYENGE TUJKO" with a preparation and decision to cause harm to the VC and others, they all went to the VC lodge and forcibly pushed the north main gate pushed away the security guards, some of them accused jumped over the north main gate and compound wall, attacked the guards who are on duty, broken the lock of the north door, glass panes of doors and windows, broken and thrown flower pots then broke the door and window glass panes in all directions in the kitchen, bed room, camp office, meeting hall etc., They also broke bin Sony LCD TV, two desktop computers, printer, Laptop of VC, book racks, shelves, sofa sets, chairs and other furniture, thrown away photographs of gods, damaged the wall paintings etc., Some of the accused went to the first floor of the building, broken the glass panes by throwing stones, attacked the videographers, beaten them and damaged their cameras, confined the VC (LW 2) and other officials for about 6 hours in the meeting room by squatting outside in large numbers, obstructed their legitimate duties. They had subjected the VC and others to criminal intimidation by attacking and surrounding and threatening them with dire-consequences by using unparliamentarily language. Sensing the mood of the accused, some students and non teaching staff came from back of the building and stood in protection of the VC and others to save from the attack of the accused. Meanwhile Police reached the HCU campus and found the accused in large number in violent mood who did not heed to the request of the police to leave the place. As police force was insufficient to retrieve the victims from the confinement of accused, additional force was requisitioned. Accordingly, additional police force was rushed and the police officers tried repeatedly to convince the accused and others by using loud speakers to leave the place. However, the accused and others did not agree and they wanted the VC to be sent out of his house. The accused raised slogans against the VC, the government and the police.

As all the efforts to convince the accused and others to leave the VC residence failed and as they continued to pose threat to the personal security of the Vice Chancellor and others, at about 1600 HRs on 22-3-2016, the police including women police force removed the accused forcibly from the VC residence. The accused A1 to A47 and others who were sent out of the VC residence, attacked on the police outside

the VC residence by indulging in stone pelting resulting in injuries to police personnel and damage of police vehicle. On 22.03.2016 at 1900 hours, the accused A4, A7, A9, A25 to A46 who were indulging in stone pelting on police were taken in to custody to prevent further violence and stone pelting while others were sent away. The arrested accused were brought to Police Station, Gachibowli effected their arrest at 2100 HRs by making necessary entries in the records. Notices U/S 41(A) Cr.P.C were issued on them and they refused to take them. Thereafter issued notices u/s 50, 50(A) Cr.PC.

Thus the investigation done so far established that the accused A1 to A46 and others have committed an offence punishable u/s 147, 452, 427, 324, 506, 353, 342, R/w 149 IPC and Sec. 3 of PDPP Act.


As the arrested accused A4, A7, A9, A25 to A46 are in a mood to continue their efforts to send away the Vice Chancellor from the university by resorting to violence and causing damage to university properties, to prevent such further violence and damage to property, they are detained. It is further submitted that the accused are being produced before the honourable court with a request to remand them to judicial custody for the following reasons.

- 1) In order to prevent the accused from committing further offences and for proper investigation of the case.
- 2) In order to prevent the accused for making any inducement threat promise to any person acquainted with the case.
- 3) Unless the accused are arrested, their presence cannot be secured as and when required.
- 4) Since the accused are involved in other cases of this PS and they may commit other offences at HCU.
- 5) In view of the above circumstances unless the above accused person are not arrested they may create law and order problem at the university.
- 6) Since the accused are from different districts and states they may leave to their native places and there is every possibility of escape, the accused are not having permanent address in Hyderabad and staying the hostels. In presence in the court of law cannot be ensured when his presence is needed in the court.
- 7) The accused are students without any movable and immovable properties in Hyderabad no one came forward to furnish the sureties nor produced any valid proof of documents .
- 8) There is very possibility that the accused may join agitation of the student unions in the HCU and create Law and Order problem.
- 9) All the accused attacked and pelted stone on the Police party , obstructed their duties while discharging their duties and causing grievous injuries

As such, the arrested accused are being produced before the honourable court under the escort of PCs.....with a prayer to

remand them to judicial custody for a period of 15 days so as to enable the investigation agency to complete the pending investigation and to file charge sheet.

Hence, the remand report.
